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VIRGINIA 3 P.M. TRAFFIC CONDITION UPDATE
*****IMPORTANT TRAFFIC UPDATE******

FAIRFAX, Va. – Due to pedestrian traffic leaving D.C. from the Inauguration, the northbound lane of I-395 is closed, this is due to pedestrian traffic on the 14th Street Bridge. Northbound traffic is being turned around at the Seminary Road exit. In addition, the eastbound lane of I-66 is also closed because of pedestrian traffic on the Roosevelt Bridge. Vehicular traffic in the eastbound lane of I-66 is being diverted to Route 110. The closure is temporary until authorities can clear pedestrians from both bridges. The HOV lanes for both interstates are also shut down until further notice.

These bridges have been designated for use by authorized vehicles only.

Traffic is slowing down on Route 1 southbound at Collard Street in Fairfax County due to a water main break that occurred last night. Motorists should anticipate a one mile back-up. Two out of three southbound lanes are closed.

There are currently no significant delays to report on transit systems serving Virginia. Transit systems across the region are all operating which includes buses, Metro and Virginia Railway Express.

Travelers who took transit to Metrorail station from Virginia Park & Ride lots, transit service is running for the return trip from Metrorail to the Park & Ride lots.

The Virginia Railway Express is reserved for people who have inauguration tickets and no tickets are available for purchase on VRE today.
