## **\*\*FINAL\*\* VIRGINIA TRAFFIC CONDITION UPDATE**

FAIRFAX, Va. – Virginia State Police have re-opened travel lanes to all vehicular traffic along I-395 northbound and I-66 eastbound inside the Capital Beltway. Traffic volume is light. The southbound lanes of I-395 and the westbound lanes of I-66 are also open to general traffic.

As a reminder, the HOV-3 lanes on I-95/I-395 southbound are in effect from 4 p.m. Jan. 20, until 3 a.m., Wednesday, Jan. 21, and from 11 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 21, until 9 p.m. for motorists departing Washington.

The I-95/395 HOV lanes will open to HOV-3 traffic northbound at 5 a.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 21.

The HOV-2 lanes along I-66 westbound are in effect from 4 p.m., Jan. 20, until 9 p.m., Wednesday, Jan. 21.

Transit systems continue to operate across the region. Transit service is running for the return trip from Metrorail to Virginia Park & Ride lots. There are no significant delays to report on transit systems serving Virginia.

In addition, Virginia transit operators are scheduled to end service today between 9 pm and 10 pm, but some operators will offer later service depending on customer demand. You should contact transit operators for exact closure times.

Virginia Railway Express ran its last trains for the day out of Union Station at 7:30 pm. The VRE reports more than 18,000 people used the commuter rail service on Tuesday, Jan. 20.

Judiciary Square and Mount Vernon Square Metrorail stations are closed for the rest of the night. As of 6 pm, Metro reports that more than 930,700 people have used the Metro system today. More information will be available tomorrow regarding attendance on transit shuttles to Metrorail and Virginia Park & Ride lot usage.
