Blanket Approval revised July 1, 1968.

The Superintendent of State Police has issued a blanket approval of sirens only, which reads:

Acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 46.2-1005 of the Code of Virginia, the Department of State Police hereby approves:

“All sirens on police and fire department vehicles and ambulances or rescue vehicles and publicly owned vehicles used by state forest wardens used for emergency calls”
