## Revised SP-65 Forms

## Clarification

Reference: 2005-1 VFTP Newsletter, VFTP Fact

Per Section 18.2-308.2:2, Code of Virginia, an exception to the multiple handgun purchase restriction is " a person who holds a valid Virginia permit to carry a concealed handgun." If, for example, a prospective purchaser has a Military ID card issued by the US Department of Defense, has PCS (Permanent Change of Station) Orders to Virginia, and is the holder of a **Virginia** Non-Resident Concealed Handgun Permit, he or she is entitled to the same multiple handgun purchase privileges as a purchaser with a Virginia Resident Concealed Handgun Permit. A nonresident permit issued by another state will not be accepted as an exemption to the purchase limitation.
