VIRGINIA STATE POLICE Advanced Defensive Tactics Training March 24-25, 2011

The Department of Criminal Justice Services, The Virginia Association of Defensive Tactics Instructors, and The Virginia State Police will sponsor a two-day seminar on Defensive Tactics to be held at the **Virginia State Police Training Academy**, Richmond, Virginia. A registration form as well as lodging and additional course information may be obtained by accessing the Virginia State Police web site www.virginiatrooper.org.

This training will focus on police officer assaults and recovering from a standing and prone position. Police Chief William H. Price, Bristol, Virginia, will be the featured Lead-Instructor. Additional instructors from the Charlottesville Police Department, Newport News Sheriff's Office, and the Virginia State Police will also assist with instruction. The two-day course will include instruction on the following topics:

- Sudden Attacks
- Striking Techniques
- Standing and Prone Combat
- Ground Combat

There is no tuition fee for this course; however, breakfast and lunch will be provided at a cost of \$8.50 for each meal. **Evening meals will not be provided.** Attendees will be responsible for lodging. They may request lodging at the Training Academy for \$10.00 a night, based on availability.

Space is limited, so early registration is recommended.

PLEASE NOTE – Class B uniform (Utilities) and Leather or Web gear is required.

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this school is to provide advanced defensive tactics instructor training only to certified and active defensive tactics instructors. It is intended to motivate and present a combined system of skills and attitudes, and to advance new ideas coupled with existing technique. This training will emphasize skill of technique rather than power.

PRE-REQUISITES: Students exhibiting preexisting medical problems that instructional staff believe could likely lead to injury will be returned to their agency without training. The applicant should be a certified defensive tactics instructor. Individuals should be in good health and able to participate in strenuous exercises. A medical examination is recommended. Participants will be required to perform push ups, sit-ups, and a one mile run/walk. In addition, they will be subjected to mental stress, physical stress, and physical confrontations with instructors and other participants.

PRIORITY: The above deadline for submission of application will be strictly observed as class size is limited. Participants will be chosen on a selected basis according to responses received.

IN-SERVICE CREDIT: 16 hours of career development in-service credit will be awarded upon successful completion.

TUITION: No charge. Add meals and Academy lodging if desired. (See Below)

MEALS: If you desire meals or rooms, please indicate same on the registration form, and add to your tuition fee. Attach the total amount to the registration form. Meals are available at the following rates:
Two breakfast meals =\$17.00 Total
Two lunch meals =\$17.00 Total
Dinner meals are not available at the Academy. Students are on their own for dinner.

LODGING: Two nights = \$20.00 Total (at Academy). Lodging is available on March 24-25, 2010. Students must **ARRIVE PRIOR TO 9:00 PM** on March 23, 2010. If lodging is requested, indicate same on registration form and add fee.

DEADLINE: March 3, 2011, at close of business, to submit application and fees.

ACCEPTANCE: Individuals will be notified whether they have been selected to attend this training. Accepted applicants will receive an information packet (what to bring, etc.). Please review closely.
